2.	Minutes of the Last Meeting The minutes of the meeting held on 03 October 2017 were signed as a true record. Kevin is still investigating purchasing a fire-proof box for the master file.		
3.	Village H (a) (b)	Paul has cut down the growth at the edges of the car park but is still to investigate what lies underneath. However, the Estate has agreed that the small patch of land near the cellar entrance to the VH can be tarmacked to provide more parking space.  The updated Terms of Hire as drafted by Doug Evans was agreed, subject to a few very minor amendments. Marion will now type this up, and send to Julie / Ant the updated version plus give them some hard copies. She will also update the Notice of Hire Charges. The Committee thanked Doug for his efforts in the redrafting of this document.  Over the winter months, rubbish should be collected fortnightly by Rabbit, but they have been collecting weekly. After some discussion they have agreed to cut back to fortnightly collections	MGT

for the winter months, and to refund the overcharge.

## 4. Planning

Various applications have been put in for small-scale tree work.

Ed suggested that the Committee (Burpham Parish Meeting) might like to consider the preparation and adoption of a Local Plan. It was considered that this is a good idea, and that villagers could be asked to help in the production of this. Ed and Kevin are to prepare a note to go in the February newsletter suggesting that the matter be discussed and set in motion at the AGM.

### 5. **Treasurer Report**

Income is currently running at higher than budgeted. £1000 has been put into each of the investments, which stand at approximately, £52,000 at present.

After some discussion it was agreed that the AGM date should be brought back to comply with government requirements that Parish Councils and Meetings hold their AGMs between 1 March and 1 June in any year. For this year, 2018, the date of Sat 28 April was agreed: in 2019 and following years the date will probably be fixed for late May. If necessary unaudited accounts will be presented at the AGM with an undertaking that if the audit materially alters them this will be brought to villagers' attention.

## 6. **Secretary Report**

New website - Marion reported that a prototype website style has been agreed and that material from the current one is ready to be transferred into it. Some of the current headings will be combined (e.g. cricket / stoolball / social etc. under "Activities" or similar).

There will be the ability for various sections of it to be edited / updated by different people, e.g. cricket, church, etc.
